ESA Board

- Free access to all genetic material for further breeding
- Limitation of patentability
 - → Raising the bar
 - → BDP Proposal: original intent of Biotech Directive
- Interface





CIPR

Proposals regarding interface:

- BDP proposal
- Compulsory License / Breeders' Privilege
- Plantum position
- Patent pool





Guidelines Board

- Once commercially available, the patented genetic material must be available for further breeding in line with the established principle
- Free availability in this context does not necessarily mean that commercialisation should be for free
- Industry-led approaches to the issue should be further investigated as this could allow for a more immediate solution than a legislative initiative
