Regulation on seed marketing

- A package: seed marketing, plant health and official controls
- COM proposal March 2013 discussion in Parliament and Council 2013 / 2014...
- Revision of the current seed marketing directives:
 a single regulation covering all species
- All operators registered under plant health regime
- A series of implementing acts to define details





Kokopelli ruling

- On the validity of the DUS requirements for vegetables & the principles of the European treaties on free movement of goods
- Question referred to European Court of Justice
- Ruling in favour of requirements as laid out to achieve the objectives of the legislation
- = in line with ESA Position!





Launch of ESTA

- New EU Regulation on plant protection products entered into force in summer 2011
- New provisions on treated seed and new labelling obligations
- Bee incident and subsequent restrictions
- ESTA: an industry-owned standard for seed treatment quality

Current debate on ban of key insecticides (neonicotinoids)

- EFSA report on bee health and insecticides 16.1.2013
- Commission proposal to ban use of neonicotinoids for seed treatment for all crops excpet sugarbeet and winter cereals
- ESA, ECPA, COPA coordination for alternatives
- ESTA is crucial for future access to pesticides for seed treatment!!!



EU Patent/ ESA IP position

- Free access to all plant genetic material for further breeding
- The commercial use of new plant varieties expressing the function of a patented element, requires the authorization of the holder of the patent right

➤Inclusion of a provision for a limited breeders' exemption in the EU Patent = ESA success!





Patent transparency / ESA patent database

- Improving transparency on patent status of genetic material
- ESA is setting up a comprehensive website with all relevant information regarding patent status of (EU) commercially available varieties

- ➤ To be presented at ISF Breeders Committee at the Athens Congress
- **➤**To be officially launched 01.07.2013







Nagoya protocol implementation

- Nagoya protocol: adopted in 2010: an international agreement on access and benefit sharing of genetic resources (ABS)
- Push for more harmonisation, setting more detailed rules for ABS
- EU will be (soon!) presenting its draft Regulation on the implementation of the Nagoya Protocol
 - Specific rules needed for plant breeding sector!





3. Public outreach and advocacy

- A growing role for the European Parliament
- Policymaking at EU level: technical to political
- 26 & 27 NOV: European lobbying training workshop with participation of AMSEM
- Romanian seed industry will have a full-time part to play in 2013!
